Pinchevski distinguishes echo from the closely related but sometimes conflated reflection, reverberation, and resonance; considers echolalia as an active, reactive, and creative vocalic force, the launching pad of speech; and explores echo as a rhetorical device, steering between appropriation and response while always maintaining relation. He examines the trope of echo chamber and both destructive and constructive echoing; describes various echo techniques and how echo can serve practical purposes from echolocation in bats and submarines to architecture and sound recording; explores echo as a link to the past, both literally and metaphorically; and considers echo as medium using Marshall McLuhan's tetrad.

**A Social-interactional Approach to Expressive Engagement in an Era of Imagined Audience and Networked Performance** Nov 11 2019 Social media and

other interactive technologies have been at the forefront of a shift toward lifestyle politics and expressive citizenship. This "unedited public sphere," once heralded as a force for greater liberation and connectivity, has nevertheless come under scrutiny in recent debates for eroding common grounds, flaming the "uncivil war," and stoking social division. While social media has garnered much scholarly attention, we still lack an integrated framework that situates expression and engagement within social media's unique architecture, characterized by context collapse, convergence of mass and interpersonal processes, and an invisible audience. This dissertation advances a social-interactional approach to understanding the expressive use of social media and its democratic implications. Specifically, I critically examine three major concerns in popular narratives about social media's failure to meet its deliberative potentials, namely, echo chambers, uncivil rhetoric, and political radicalization and intolerance. In this dissertation, I present three projects to illustrate how a theoretical lens that foregrounds social interactional processes and its underpinning foundation -affordances, context, and audience - can be useful in guiding the rethinking of these contemporary challenges. The main findings are summarized below. In the first project, I integrate issue frames and affordances theory to expand the notion of the echo chamber, which typically focuses on ideological and issue position alignment. Using a combination of computational content and network analytical techniques, including supervised machine learning and structural topic modeling, this project analyzes Twitter conversations about Covid-19 vaccines, structured around distinct interaction functions and actor types. The results demonstrate that, compared to retweets, quote tweets afford a greater potential for cross-cutting encounters, connecting users to "public spheres" of different kinds. Overall, the results speak to the need to broaden the concept of echo chambers with more nuanced observations regarding what constitutes the chamber and what is being echoed. The second project examines users' differential reactions to uncivil expressions, depending on several situational cues that assist their "reading of the context." Through a series of experiment-embedded surveys, this project examines three situational cues-@usernames addressivity, group labels, and injunctive norms-that shape users' reactions to political incivility. Results suggest that identical uncivil language is more tolerated by ingroup audiences who readily agree with the content, but this is the case only when the uncivil exchange is perceived as "between opposing camps," not "targeting individuals." Moreover, normative cues are important in shaping spectator audiences' incivility perception and corrective action. The project thus joins a bulk of work on discursive context and its relationship with expression

behaviors. Lastly, using multi-national survey datasets, the third project provides empirical evidence that self-expression is related to extreme political attitudes and reduced networked interaction, but the association is contingent on who the expresser has in mind as their audience. This expressive pathway, however, is relatively muted in societies with more restricted expression opportunities and media systems. Moreover, attention to and uncertainty about one's audience is far from being universal; it is related instead to both network and platform features, as well as several personality traits. Importantly, attention to one's audience is related to frontstage privacy behaviors (which occur during interaction), but not backstage privacy practice (which operates in the background, such as changing settings for profile visibility). Using the notion of networked performance and imagined audience, this dissertation offers a productive way forward in theorizing social media privacy practice and expanding current scholarship on expression effects. Taken together, this dissertation advances a theoretical framework that incorporates insights from mass and interpersonal communication research as well as capitalizes on mixed-methods approaches in our attempts to understand expressive social media use and its deliberative potential in fostering more open and pluralistic societies.

This shifts the current status to a new age: The Era of Exponential Encryption, so the vision and description of the authors. If routing does not require destination information but is replaced by cryptographic insights, then it is "beyond cryptographic routing".
